5. In today's first reading, we hear an amazing story about that happened to Jesus' disciples after Jesus had left them to return to heaven. They were all gathered in a room together and all of a sudden, the Holy Spirit came to them like a strong wind. And in that moment, the disciples were given a special gift. They were given the gift to speak to all people and to let them know about God. **What is something that you know about God/Jesus that you can tell your friends in school about?**

6. In today's Gospel, we hear a story of two men on the road and all of a sudden Jesus appears to them. But they didn't recognize Jesus at first because the two men were there the day that he died on the cross and didn't know that he had risen from the dead on Easter Sunday. They recognized Jesus only when he sat down with them to share a meal, but not just any meal, but to share with them the same meal he shared with his disciples at the Last Supper. **What is your favorite type of food to eat? When you eat that meal, do you share it with anyone?**

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7. Jesus wants us to live good and holy lives, but sometimes this can be a hard thing to do. There can be times when we do not know what the right thing to do is. Fortunately, we have many role models we can look up to who show us how to follow Jesus. Parent Question:
