Option for Funeral Eulogy: If a eulogy is to be given at church, it will be given upon arrival in the church. The parish policy is that ONLY ONE person may speak and from a prepared text to be submitted to the priest the day before the Mass and should be no more than 4-5 minutes in length. (This policy is strictly adhered to in keeping with the sanctity of the Mass.) Another option preferred by many is that the eulogy be given either during the time of the Wake the evening before or morning of , or at the reception following the Mass instead of at Holy Mass.
