7. Jesus healed many sick people while He was on earth, but what do we do now when someone is sick? Jesus gave us the Sacrament called the Anointing of the Sick, which is given to people who are very sick to help them get better. The word anoint means to rub with oil, which is part of what happens in this Sacrament.
