HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Thursday, August 15, 2019

Vigil Mass: Wednesday, August 14 at 7:00pm

Holy Day Mass: Thursday, August 15 at 8:00am and 7:00pm

Celebrated every year on August 15, the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary commemorates the death of Mary and her bodily assumption into Heaven. Because it signifies the Blessed Virgin's passing into eternal life, it is probably the most important of all Marian feasts as well as being a Holy Day of Obligation. The Feast of the Assumption is one of the oldest holy days in the Church, with accounts of celebrations going back to the sixth century. But it was only 1950 that Pope Pius XII, exercising papal infallibility, declared in an Apostolic constitution known as the *Munificentissimus Deus* that it is a dogma of the Church "that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life,

AUGUST 10 – 11

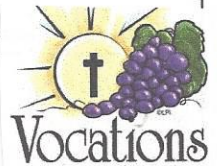
