Saint John Henry Newman

John Henry Newman was a theologian and poet. First an Anglican priest and later a Roman Catholic priest and cardinal, he was an important and controversial figure in the religious history of England in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. In 1854, at the request of the Irish Catholic Bishops, he went to Dublin as rector of the new Catholic University. It was during this time that he founded the Literary and Historical Society.

After four years, he retired. He published a volume of lectures entitled The Idea of a University. A number of Newman Centers have been established in his honor throughout the world. They provide pastoral services and ministries to Catholics at non-Catholic universities.

In 1991, Newman was proclaimed venerable by Pope John Paul II after a thorough examination of his life and work by the Congregation for the Causes of Saints. In 2001, an American deacon attributed his recovery from a spinal cord disorder to the intercession of Newman. The approval of a further miracle at the intercession of Newman was reported in November 2018: the healing of a pregnant woman from a grave illness. He was canonized on October 13, 2019.
