Bishop Kihneman has authorized the implementation of a new Diaconate Formation Class with two tracks: One in English and one in Spanish.

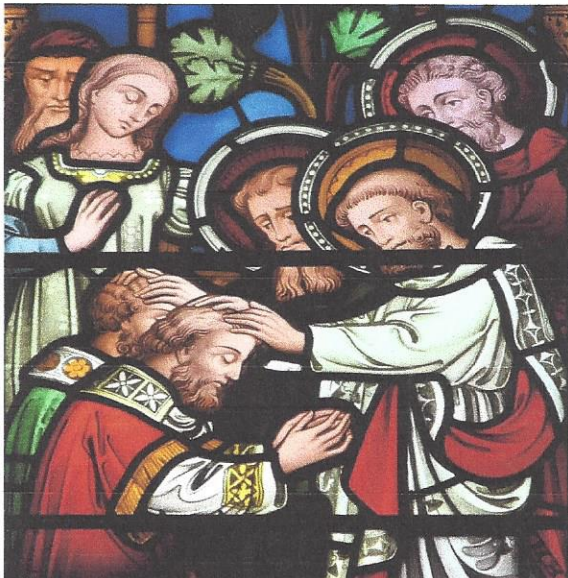
Pre-selection information sessions will be conducted from 8:30 – noon on the following days:
