SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is not observed as a holy day of obligation this year because it falls on a Saturday.

The Assumption is, according to the beliefs of the Catholic Church, Eastern Orthodox Churches and Oriental Orthodoxy, among others, the bodily taking up of Mary, the mother of Jesus, into Heaven at the end of her earthly life. The Catholic Church teaches as dogma that the Virgin Mary “having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory”. This dogma was defined by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950. The New Testament contains no explicit narrative about the death or dormition, nor the Assumption of Mary, but several scriptural passages have been theologially interpreted to describe the ultimate fate in this and the afterworld of the Mother of Jesus.
