What Happens if Someone Drops a Consecrated Host?

Despite our best efforts, and this is as true in our liturgical celebrations as in all of life, accidents happen. According to No. 280 of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, the general rule is that a dropped host is picked up by the minister distributing Communion and reverently consumed. The minister should be careful to make sure that no other particles from the host remain on the ground.
