



### AGAA PARENT/BOARD MEETING 9/29/19

- AGAA Board Members introduced themselves to the parents at the meeting and gave a short synopsis of their role.
- Review of AGAA by-laws-policies- President Dana Schirnhofner read and discussed some pertinent points in the by-laws eg: demerits, academic eligibility, attendance, student-drop-off, parent responsibility, grievances, physical dating, and uniforms.
- Uniforms: uniforms will have a scheduled drop-off/turn-in so that there is tracking for each athlete. If an athlete does not turn in their current uniform the next sport uniform will not be given out and if the uniform is lost or damaged a fee will be assessed for the replacement cost of the uniform. AGAA will set up return dates/times for the Fall Sport Uniforms
- Treasurer's Report: Matt Phillips gave the treasurer's report and to date of 9/27/19 the Available Balance is \$15,328.07
- AGAA updates:
  - Uniforms: all uniforms are ordered and either in service or to be delivered before the winter sport season. The only outstanding uniform to be purchased is boys' volleyball.
  - Registration: Online TeamSnap registration for the winter basketball season is October 4<sup>th</sup>.
  - The AGS website has a current gym calendar and sport calendar that is updated with the current activities at each gym listed.
- Fall tournaments: Basketball has elected to enter the Divine Mercy tournament for JV boys/girls November 7-10. This school has supported all of our tournaments in the past and therefore we are in support of their tournament
- OLSH boys/girls tournaments in November. Boys are entered and girls are waiting for date/conflict.
- The annual away Varsity boys/girls tournament is scheduled for Akron on November 23/24. Coaches will check for player availability.
- OTHER DISCUSSION TOPICS:
  - Checking on availability of STMS gym to use as an alternative practice location
  - Discussion on gym calendar/practice times for upcoming winter sports

- Reminder that Spring play stage will be built on April 13 and the play will run May 7-9.
  - Adidas team store to reopen in November
  - Coach suggestion for an athletic open house where the students/parents can come and talk to the coaches for various sports and learn what each sport entails
- **FALL SPORT COACH UPDATES**
    - Cheer: The diocesan championship competition will be held at AGS March 28<sup>th</sup>. The cheer team will enter 3 competitions during February/March.
    - Cross Country: The season is well under way and going strong. The team has taken home a JV 1<sup>st</sup> place and a Varsity 2<sup>nd</sup> place at the South Hills Invitational. The Championship Meet will be Oct. 19
    - Soccer: All teams 1-JV/Varsity have had games both home and away and the season is running smoothly
    - Track/Field: March 1<sup>st</sup> is the first day allowed for practice and tentatively they will be running again at Carlynton track. May have an open meeting to discuss what is involved in track/field for those novice runners/field athletes.
    - Volleyball: Girls volleyball is doing well and the season is underway. Boys volleyball will begin in the spring.
    - Basketball: The official practice start date for basketball is Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> and Developmental will start at the beginning of November. There will be evaluations for dividing the JV boys basketball teams into 3 teams.
