REGISTRATION

Registration for new students for the 2021-2022 school year, will take place on-line from Tuesday, February 16, 2021, through Friday, February 19, 2021. After you have completed your forms, you may drop the forms off at the School Office. Please use the front door by the flag pole, ring the door bell and leave your paper work in the box inside the door.

ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance to our school is based on the following criteria:

1. For kindergarten, a child must be 5 years of age by October 1, 2021.
For first grade, a child must be 6 years of age by October 1, 2021.
2. Kindergarten students will be expected to take the Kindergarten Readiness Test and students in other grades will be tested on material covered in Math, Reading and English on their grade level at a scheduled time. Due to Covid there may be other options.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Each family is asked to provide 60 hours of service to the school (more information will follow depending on Covid).
2. There are two mandatory fundraiser during the year. 50/50 raffle and Scrip. More info will follow.
3. Attendance at H.S.A. meetings and support of H.S.A. projects.
4. Copy of previous report card and standardized test results (grades 1-8).

REGISTRATION FEE – \$475.00 per child (for instructional materials, testing fees, technology fees, Diocesan School Alliance fees, H.S.A. dues, student insurance, art supplies)

NON-REFUNDABLE & NON-TRANSFERABLE OUTSIDE OF IMMEDIATE FAMILY

Priority will be given to those who are registered parishioners of St. Helena Parish. Students coming from a Catholic school in the Diocese of Metuchen that may be closing will also have priority.

All new students will be tested/screened before acceptance is final. This is usually done in the spring.

The completion of a registration form should not be deemed acceptance to St. Helena School. An application will not be considered complete until all the necessary paper work has been submitted, including immunization records.

TUITIONS

CATHOLIC – CONTRIBUTING PARISHIONER PLAN.

MEDICAL RECORDS:

-DPT minimum of 4 Boosters-5th dose if 4th one given prior to age 4

-Polio minimum of 3 Boosters-4th dose if 3rd one given prior to age 4

-2 Measles, Mumps and Rubella vaccine

-Hepatitis B vaccine - series of 3 must comply with new state guidelines

-Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccine after age 1

- Students born on or after 1/1/97 or entering grade 6

- need 1 Tdap by age 11

- need Meningococcal conjugate vaccine at age 11

-It is the policy of our school, and state law, to require a physical examination by the child's physician for all new children entering school. Forms will be available at the time of registration.

BUSING INFORMATION - Students, who live 2 or more miles from school and live in the area where busing is available, are eligible for free busing. If there is no busing in your area, you may be reimbursed by the State Transportation Department, provided you live at least 2 miles from school and reimbursement is available.

It is the responsibility of the parents to fill out an APPLICATION FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION (B6T) for each child attending St. Helena School. These forms will be given out at registration and must be returned to the school. The transportation department will determine your eligibility for busing or reimbursement. They will notify you if you are eligible for service. **THE TRANSPORTATION NUMBER FOR EDISON IS (732) 452-4562. THE TRANSPORTATION NUMBER FOR WOODBRIDGE IS (732)-596-4136. You need to call the transportation department in your district if you do not live in Edison or Woodbridge.**

STUDENT AID APPLICATION - Tuition assistance is available to economically disadvantaged families whose children attend a catholic school in the Diocese of Metuchen. There are two sites: "The Foundation for Catholic Education" and "Hope through Education", where applications can be made. For more information or to apply go to: <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>. Documentation such as: 2018 Federal Tax Return, 2019 W2 or 1099 forms, Social Security Income, etc. will be required. The deadline of March 31, 2020, for submission is strictly enforced. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

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
