Pastors letter

Dear parishioners,

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. At the end of the 11 AM Mass, we will have solemn Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament concluding at 3 PM with the chanting of the Divine Mercy Chaplet and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. This will be followed by the veneration of our beautiful Divine Mercy Image.

As well, following the 11 AM Mass, Fr. Drew and I will be hearing Confessions. What better way to experience Divine Mercy than through the Sacrament of Penance!

Beginning Monday and finishing on Wednesday, the priests of the diocese will be gathering in Columbus, Georgia (as far away as you can get in our diocese from Savannah) for our annual Clergy Conference. Fr. Drew will celebrate Monday morning's Mass. On Tuesday and Wednesday, we will have a Communion Service in place of Mass.

Wednesday begins May first and the last month of school. As many of you know, Fr. Drew Larkin will be leaving the parish at the end of May to go and study Canon Law at Catholic University in Washington, DC. His last weekend here will be May 25/26. He will preach all the Masses and we will have a going away reception for him following the 8:30 AM Mass on Sunday, May 26th.

As well, our seminarian Nate Swan will be ordained a transitional deacon on Saturday, May 25 at our Cathedral downtown at 10:00 AM. He will assist at our two Sunday morning Masses as the deacon with Fr. Drew giving his good-bye homily. We will also congratulate Deacon Nate at Father Drew's farewell reception.

The weekend of June 1st and 2nd, Deacon Nate will preach all the Masses which will be his first time ever giving a Sunday homily! Yikes!

Another date you will want to place in your calendar is the ordination to the priesthood of Deacon Patrick May. It will be on Saturday, June 1st at 10 AM at our Cathedral. Patrick was an altar server at the Church of the Most Holy Trinity in Augusta when I was pastor there in the 1990's early 2000's.

Three other deacons will be ordained priests for our diocese in their native Africa. Thus, we will have four new priests this summer. I have been assured that we will get a full time priest replacement for Fr. Drew. At this point, I don't know who that will be. Unfortunately for you and me, new assignments don't begin until August 1st.

I do hope we will have a seminarian for the summer, but I don't know who that will be yet either. The diocese likes keeping me in the dark.

I pray you have a blessed Divine Mercy Sunday!

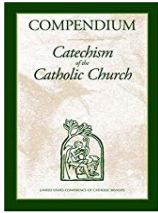

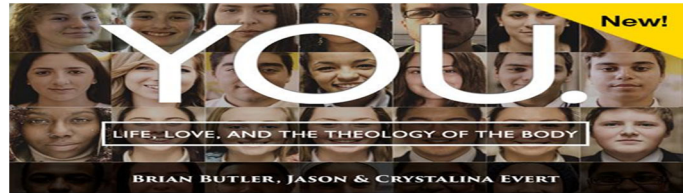

Saint Anne Youth Ministry

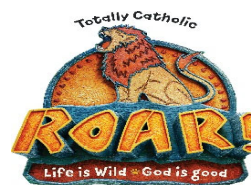
