Average family size is four, two adults with two children

Grocery store, Grub Hub, Door Dash gifts cards are welcome

Fresh and prepackaged snacks & drinks are also welcome

You do not have to call ahead of time, just come by during our hours of operation

HOME continues to advocate and connect families to community resources that are available to them. With several families unable to return to their homes currently, providing fresh meals assists with access to food.
