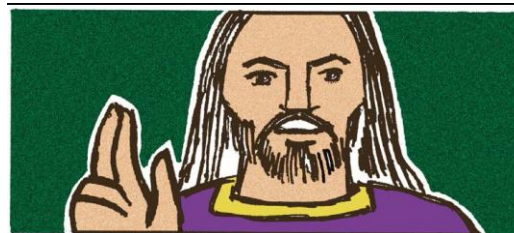

BLESSING OF VEHICLES

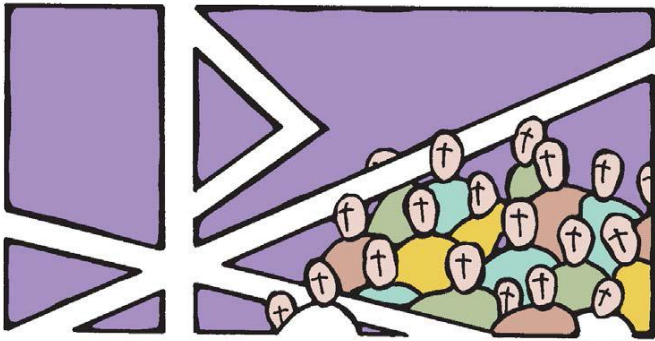

A MINDSET OF SERVICE

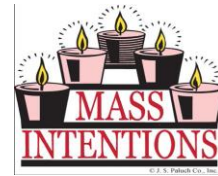

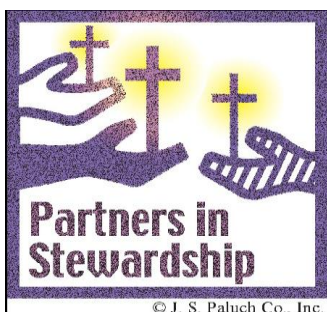
