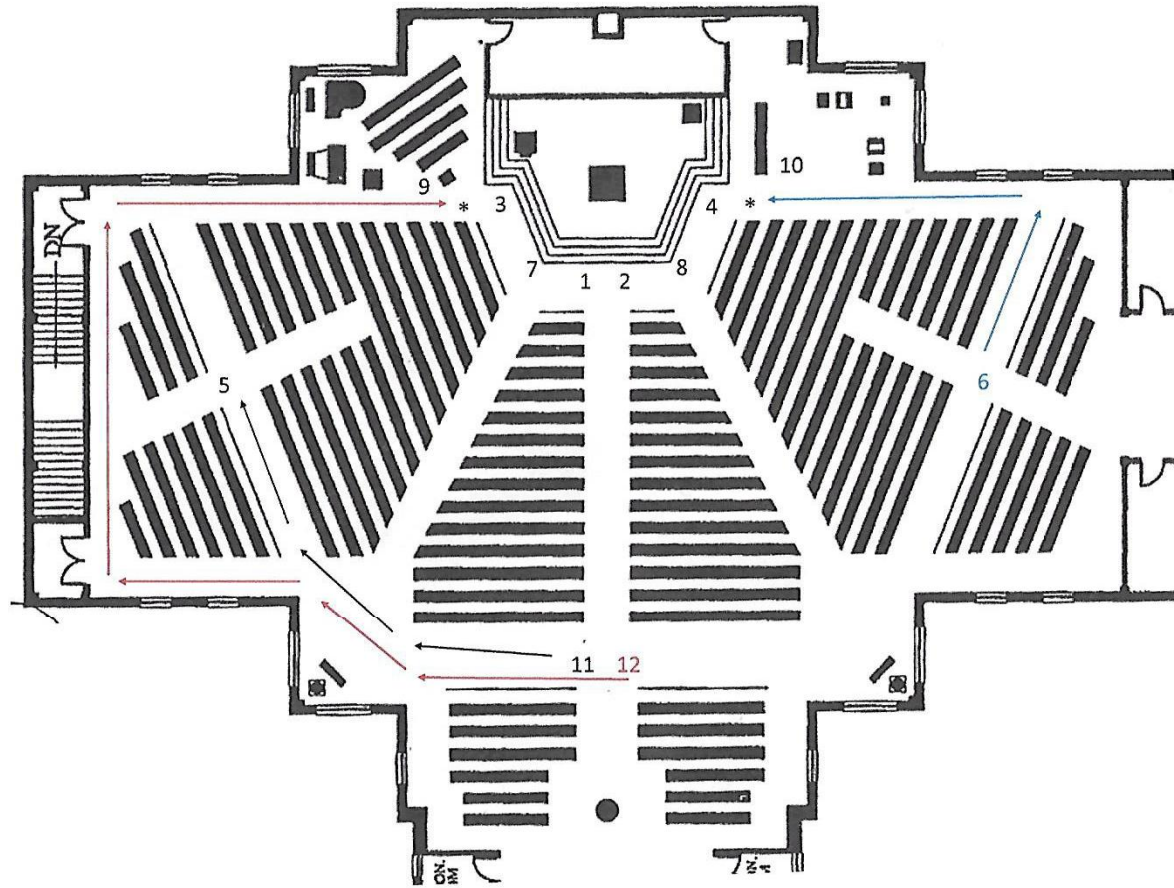


Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist—Diagram and Assisting Instructions



All Eucharistic Ministers are required to purify their hands before lining up at their Station and receiving the Eucharist.
All Eucharistic Ministers, please walk briskly to and from your Station.

Assisting Stations - When stations 11 and 12 have served all communicants in the chairs, Station 11 should walk to stations 5, stand next to him/her, serving the back section. When finished, turn around to start serving the back rows of that side/front section. Station 12 will walk around the choir side of the church and go directly to assist Stations 3. (see asterisk) Station 6 will assist station 4 if needed. (see asterisk)

Serving at the 10:30 Mass - Station 3, 5 and 9 should distribute the Eucharist and Precious Blood to the Choir first and then proceed to their designated stations. **ONLY** Station 4, Minister of the Host, should serve the **Sunrise Assisted Living** residents seated in the first row and then proceed to their designated station. The Precious Blood will not be offered to the residents, so station 10C can proceed right to their station.
