## LENTEN DISCIPLINES

**Ash Wednesday (March 6) and Good Friday (April 19) are days of fast AND abstinence.**

Abstinence is also to be observed on all the Fridays of Lent.

**Fasting** is required of all the faithful in good health from the age of 18 to the beginning of their 60<sup>th</sup> year. Fasting is usually interpreted to mean one full meal and, if necessary, two other small meals. One should not eat between meals, but milk, fruit juices, and other liquids are permitted.

**Abstinence** binds everyone over the age of 14. Abstinence means no meat should be eaten during the entire day.

Anyone unable to observe the fast and abstinence obligations because of health or other serious reasons should substitute another penance.

These simple forms of self-denial help to remind us of the Lord's Passion and Death. We offer them to God for our own conversion to Christ, and the conversion of the whole world. They can also be an occasion to grow in self-discipline and solidarity with the poor.

“The Lord God took Abram outside and said, ‘Look up at the sky and count the stars, if you can. Just so,” he added, “shall your descendants be.’” If you read this passage carefully, you find out that a few verses later it says, “As the sun was about to set, a trance fell upon Abram, and a deep, terrifying darkness enveloped him.”

God invited Abram to trust His power to fulfill His promise, even when it wasn't possible to see that clearly. (God told Abram that his descendants would be as numerous as the stars in the sky while it was daylight, and the stars were not visible!!!) God calls us to trust His power to fulfill His promises in our lives, even when it is often not visible or clear to us how that could happen.

Where in your life is God calling you to trust Him beyond what you can “see,” beyond what you currently understand? Our Lenten disciplines of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving can help us open up space in our minds and hearts to receive more than we expect!
