“Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to come! Hosanna in the highest!” These words greeted Jesus as He entered Jerusalem, as the crowds waived their branches and laid down their cloaks, and shouted! Do we approach Holy Week with anticipation and joy? Do we lay down the things that might distract us, so we can focus on this encounter with our Lord Jesus?

We enter together this Sunday into Holy Week, the epicenter of what it means to be a Christian, the epicenter of the reason for our hope. We will walk with the Lord in His Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

This Wednesday at 5:30 pm we have the **Living Stations of the Cross** put on by our faith formations students! Thank you in advance to everyone who has prepared this prayer!

Please make every effort to keep the **Easter Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil**. We are required to abstain from meat and fast on Good Friday, and warmly encouraged to fast through Holy Saturday if possible until we arrive at our Easter Feast!

St. Anne’s has the privilege of hosting our **Holy Thursday Eucharistic Adoration after the Mass of the Lord’s Supper**. Please come and “watch one hour” with the Lord!

This is the richest and most beautiful time of the year to make a good confession, especially if you’ve been away for a while. There will be confessions:

- Monday at St. Anne’s Penance Service, 6 pm
- Tues. evening during Adoration at St. Al’s (~8 pm)
- Weds. at St. Anne’s after Stations of the Cross
- Weds. at St. Al’s at 7:30 pm
- Holy Saturday at St. Al’s at 11 am
- Easter Sunday morning at 8 am at St. Anne’s

On Holy Saturday, we have renewed an ancient tradition, the **Blessing of the Easter Food**, at 10 am. We ask God’s special blessing on the food that will be used for the Easter Feast!

Please pray in a special way in these days for all those who are preparing to be baptized at the Easter Vigil, and all those who, already baptized, will come into full communion with the Church! Their journeys are varied and unique, but it is a great joy for us as the Body of Christ to prepare to welcome them!

These beautiful services of Holy Week are a GREAT time to invite your family members and friends... bring them to confession, to Living Stations, to Holy Thursday Adoration, to the Triduum!
