“Of this land and the church, no one will be the only owner, all together will own it; the priest will own it, so that he may say Mass here, and that he may preach here... but the Indians will own it, to worship there... The priest will never be able to sell it; and the Indians who are living here now, and who will be praying here... will not be able to sell this piece of land and the church.” Agreement signed by Baraga and Native Americans for Holy Cross Church

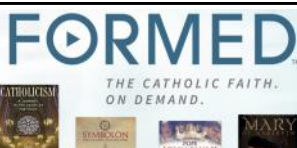
