As you can see, we have shifted to our combined bulletin for the summer. The spring semester is over at Michigan Tech, and we've shifted to our simpler summer liturgical schedule. That means the Saturday evening and Sunday evening Masses are suspended at St. Al's, to return in late August / early September, and the St. Anne's Saturday evening Mass has returned to its 5:30 pm time (confessions at 4:30 pm).

We have ample opportunity for Eucharistic Adoration in the summer, a very powerful way to go deeper in prayer. 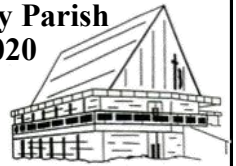
