**From the desk of Fr. Ben... 30 June 2019**

There have been some big feasts kicking off this weekend! On Friday there was the third big post-Pentecost celebration, the **Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** (following Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi)! Then, on Saturday, the **Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul**, marking their martyrdom in Rome. In highlighting Jesus' burning love for us, and the fierce total commitment to Jesus exhibited by St. Peter and St. Paul in embracing martyrdom rather than deny the Lord, I think we have a powerful demonstration of **the words of our Second Reading:**

**Brothers and sisters: For freedom Christ set us free; so stand firm and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery.**

**For you were called for freedom, brothers and sisters. But do not use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh; rather, serve one another through love.**

Freedom in Christ is the freedom to serve, to lay down one's life, to seek the Truth and commit to Him entirely! Jesus, the Way, the Truth, the Life shows us the way by His own gift of self on the Cross... Sts. Peter and Paul follow in His footsteps. **How are we being called to walk after them in true freedom, the gift of self?**

As I type this, I'm getting ready for a **St. Al's Cookout in Dallas, TX** with Rhen. We have a nice group of alumni families coming! The next stop is the **University of Mary in Bismarck, ND to meet our new FOCUS missionaries!** Then, on Sunday night, I'll be home! The travel is for good reasons, but it's nice to be back, even briefly. On Wednesday, July 3rd I leave for 10 days of vacation with my family... we're going to Ireland! I've never been there before, but my maternal grandmother, Kathleen Savage, was Irish and her family came from there. I've had a lot of travel this year, but not much vacation, so **I'm really grateful for a chance to take a break, and for Fr. Dustin who is doing such a great job holding down the fort!**

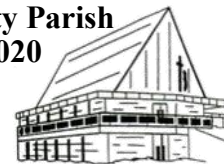
