SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR BY CHURCH OFFICIALS OR VOLUNTEERS

We are open to and respect your complaint. You are important. We want to make this process as safe as possible. **Victim's Assistance Coordinators** are there to help those who have been harmed through the difficult and sometimes painful process of healing and hope. How to begin the process:

We always encourage you to report the incident to local civil authorities. The Diocese of Marquette reports all allegations to the appropriate civil authorities.



Several times each year, the people of Israel went up to the Temple in Jerusalem for the great Jewish holy days and feasts. In the centuries before Jesus' time, that would include people coming from many places far away throughout the Ancient Near East and the Mediterranean. Perhaps this was in the prophet's imagination as he proclaimed something even more striking:

They shall bring all your brothers and sisters from **all the nations** as an offering to the LORD, on horses and in chariots, in carts, upon mules and dromedaries, to Jerusalem, my holy mountain, says the LORD, just as the Israelites bring their offering to the house of the LORD in clean vessels.

Isaiah is prophesying that not on the Jews scattered around the world will be gathered, **but even that all the nations will come.** God will extend His covenant and blessing not only to His Chosen People, but to all nations!

We believe that in the Catholic Church in our own time, we see the real but incomplete fulfilment of this prophecy, as people from every race and tongue around the world gather for the Sunday Eucharist this weekend! Incomplete only in the sense that we believe God is still calling more people, indeed all people, into His covenant and family.

Let's make that concrete and specific... we believe God is calling every single one of our family members and friends, all of our co-workers and neighbors, every person in Houghton County, into the fullness of His love and joy, into His Church! We may not be able to picture that in every case, we may not see clearly how that would be accomplished... but we're invited to start from this conviction, that God is calling everyone!

We have some great resources to help us in this mission! The Faith Formation year is beginning! Sr. Jacqueline will be teaching a new Bible Class, and our parish Formed.org subscription can be used by us all in our homes, on our phones and other devices! There are lots of resources in the church entrances. Most importantly, we have regular Mass, Confessions, Adoration... a lot of grace offered to us!

Come Holy Spirit! Move in our parish to welcome and invite all the people You are calling into the full joy of the Church!
