From the desk of Fr. Ben...

This past Wednesday we celebrated a truly beautiful feastday, that of St. Augustine. The painting here depicts him weeping in the climactic moment of his conversion. One of his most famous lines his spiritual autobiography, The Confessions is also cited, "Late have I loved You, O Beauty every ancient and ever new!" Augustine

lamented how slow he had been to respond to God's grace... but then he did respond, and in a tremendously fruitful and beautiful way! What about you and me?

Our Gospel and our First Reading talk about the importance of humility: "Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God." and "For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

What is humility? It is a positive virtue, a beautiful thing! I worry that we often think of it in negative terms, when in fact it is something we can choose in joy and happiness of heart. It seems to me that a sure path into humility is gratitude... to acknowledge that all we have and all we are is a gift from God!

There is no true humility in denigrating a good gift we have received, only ingratitude. So humility cannot mean that we fail to recognize good gifts, including gifts and talents we may have, or good things we have done or accomplished. But, it does mean never forgetting that God is at the center all we have and are or have achieved. Life and breath and opportunity come from God!

We have a great deal to be grateful for here in our parish! I recently sent out our annual report with a brief cover letter. Thank you so much for all your generosity in prayer and service, and financially, in our parish family! God has truly blessed St. Anne's Parish!

All this is given to us so that we might cooperate with God's grace in transforming the world! We have some great resources to help us in this mission!




Along with prayer, Confession, Eucharist, and spiritual counsel, our faith encourages us to seek tested healing resources, among them many good 12-step programs. Several such groups
