Words of Wisdom from Bishop Frederic Baraga

Bishop Baraga had slowed and he had signs of palsy. He preached his last sermons in three languages in St. Ann's Church, at Hancock, and he said so himself, for he felt that his voice was failing. September 1866



I think we've all heard the expression about "the tail wagging the dog," the implication being that something is in charge that shouldn't be! This is part of what Jesus is getting at in our Gospel today.

"In the same way, any-one of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple."

Do our possessions end up owning us, sometimes? Do we make decisions and

spend time and money so as to sustain things rather than people? **Does our relationship with God and with neighbor come first?** God is the one who has made all the good things of this world, and He does call us to use them in His service... but He doesn't want to worship them instead of Himself!

This Sunday we are kicking off **the new Faith Formation year!** We'll be making pizzas on Sunday afternoon with youth and parents. The schedule for the next few weeks is to the left. There are few things we do as a parish that are more important than this proactive handing on of the faith to our youth in co-operation with their families! **We are all called to participate in this process, not least by our daily prayer and intercession for our youth and their parents!**
