In modern times, the false claims of political systems and ideologies to absolute authority have increased. Various political utopias have been the justification of untold violence.

In contrast, the Church places before our eyes the Lord Jesus who reigns as our crucified and risen Lord, He who laid down His life for us! Jesus rules all things sweetly by His gentle power. **We ask God for the grace and wisdom to live and speak with Jesus as the Lord and King of our lives!**

Thursday we celebrate the civic feast of Thanksgiving, which makes no sense at all unless **there is SOMEONE to whom we give thanks!** We know WHO that is: God, Creator of all! May we truly give thanks and praise to God this week as we enjoy the blessings of family and friends and food. We also remember the great gift of being free to practice our faith!

Know of my warm gratitude to you for all of your support and generosity to our parish, to our diocese, and to Fr. Dustin and I personally! It is truly a blessing and joy to serve as your priests here at St. Anne’s. May we allow the Lord to draw us all deeper into His Love and Truth!
