“Paul, called to be an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God... to the church of God ..., to you who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be holy, with all those everywhere **who call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ**, their Lord and ours.” **In our second reading, we have this beautiful address** by St. Paul to the people of Corinth. He broadens his audience to include “all...

who call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

From St. Paul to the present, through 2000 years Christians have called upon the name of Jesus. It is a name that has power, power to save, power to protect, power to light the path in confusion or spiritual attack.

Among others, St. Bernadine of Siena helped popularize devotion to Jesus’ name, not least using **the simple monogram of the first three letters of “Jesus” in the original Greek** of the New Testament. This is typically rendered with capital letters thus: “**IHS**.”

Not knowing the history, some people have suggested this means “In His Service,” or even “In Hoc Signo” from the Latin message given to Constantine (which fully translated is rendered, “In this sign you will conquer). But it’s simpler than all that... it’s the first three letters of the name of Jesus, and it signals simply His Holy Name: Jesus.

**May we not only avoid taking the Lord’s name in vain... but may we use it well, calling upon Jesus in every need, in every joy, and in every sorrow.** Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God, have mercy on me, a sinner!
