We had a great trip to the seminary this past weekend. In the end, we had a group of 26 men, which included Fr. Robb and I. Here they are with some of our seminarians. We went out and about in Detroit on Sunday afternoon to visit some of the beautiful and historic churches. It was very encouraging to experience these young men's openness to the possibility of the priesthood in their lives. **Thank you for your prayers for them, and for our seminarians!**

At the end of this past semester, our parishioner Jack Kinnunen discerned out of seminary formation. This means that as the fruit of his own prayer, and in collaboration with his spiritual director, he has reached the conclusion that he is not being called to the priesthood. Jack is a good man, and I'm sorry to see him step out of formation, but at the same time I am confident that he is doing this as the fruit of prayer and listening to God. It is a natural and healthy part of any vocations program to have some men prayerfully enter, and subsequently come to the realization that they are not in fact being called to the priesthood. I am grateful to Jack for his 3.5 years of study and discernment. He has returned to St. Mary's University this spring semester as a non-seminary student to finish his undergraduate degree.

We have a new time for our weekly Eucharistic Holy Hour. Not many people have been able to come on Thursday evenings. After discussing it with Dcn. Tom (who is generous in organizing this every week), we are going to move the Holy Hour to Tuesday at 4:30 pm, preceding the Tuesday evening Mass.
