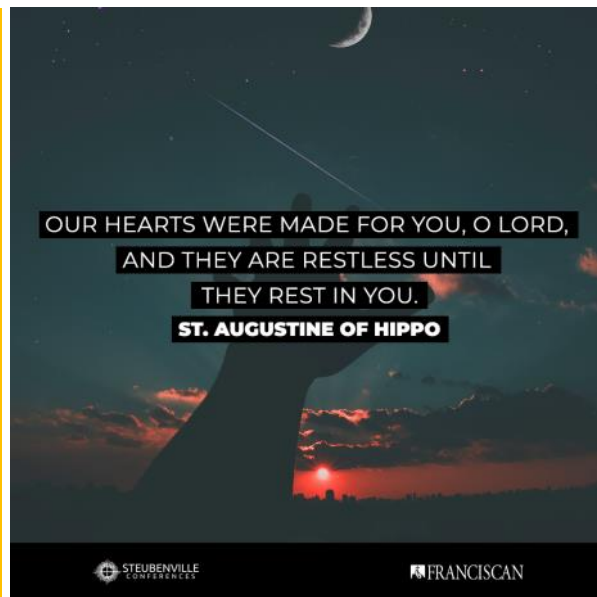

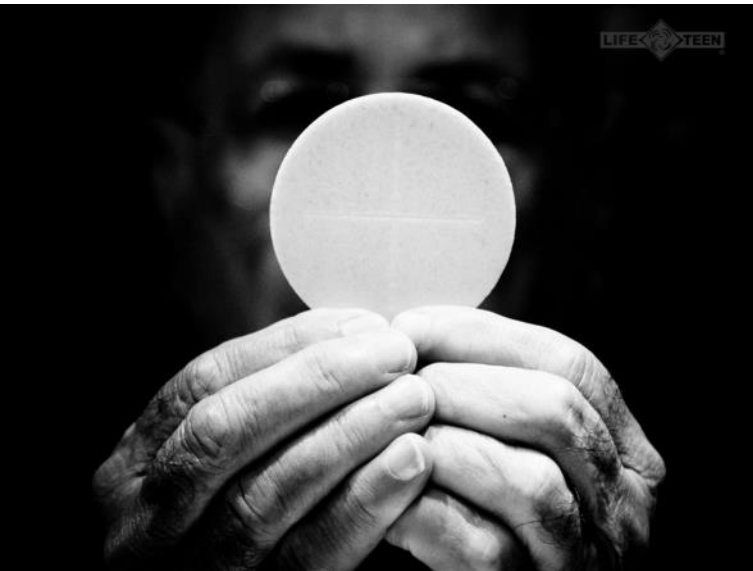

“For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him.” With these striking words right at the heart of John 6, Jesus teaches us the true nature of the Eucharist! When we receive the consecrated species, we receive Jesus Christ Himself, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

Perhaps we have greater cause than ever to dwell on this mystery with gratitude and joy as we have been limited in our ability to receive and to celebrate the Mass publicly. **We ask God to deepen our faith** and enflame our hearts with gratitude and joy at the gift of the Eucharist!

We're settling back into a normal Mass schedule, with the addition of our 7 pm Sunday Parking Lot Mass. As we get some new COVID19 cases in the area, please carefully observe the social distancing in church, wearing masks, and some other simple procedures. We'll be avoiding singing for now, as singing can increase the risk of spreading the virus. We will continue to forgo the congregational Sign of Peace, and receiving from the chalice. Our liturgies will be simpler and more austere for some time.

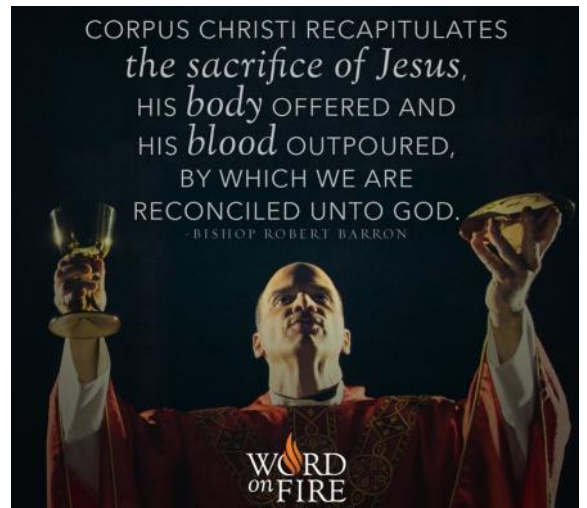
