From the desk of Fr. Ben...

21 June 2020



“Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father’s knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid; **you are worth more than many sparrows.**” That’s a handsome bird, and a common one in our parts, the white-throated sparrow! There are so many of them... and with some frequency we might encounter one that has hit a window or been hit by a car. Jesus tells us that the Father holds every single sparrow in His Love... **how much more does He hold us in His Love at every moment!**

We are living in a time of anxiety, frustration, anger, and discouragement. The readings this Sunday are VERY timely... although it may be hard to see, hard to understand, hard to trust... **being Christians means knowing and trusting that the Father is holding us in His Love and Providence at every moment, even now.** He with us, He is near, He is Love! How do we cooperate with this truth?

Let’s keep asking God for help to be the face of His Presence in our own comportment and behavior! **Do we speak, act, relate, live in light of His perfect love?** Is our behavior proportionate to the trust we have in Him? Come Holy Spirit, help each one of us by your power!

I have adjusted our confession and adoration schedules this week, please note the details in the box to the left. It is a blessing to be back to a regular schedule of public liturgies!! Please continue to observe the social distancing in church, wearing masks, and some other simple procedures. Don’t forget that we’re playing the long game, to stay safe and healthy as a community all the way through this, however long it takes!

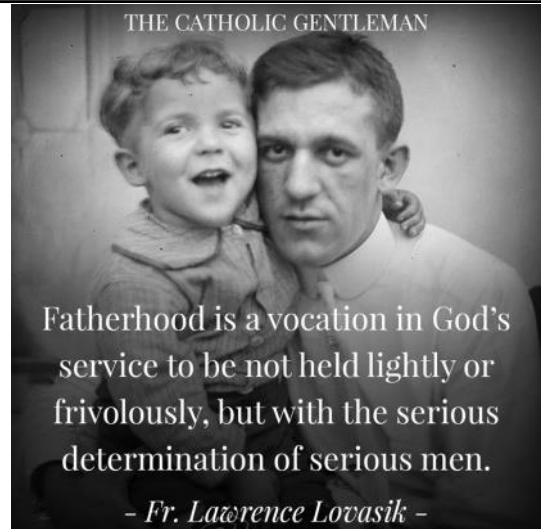
