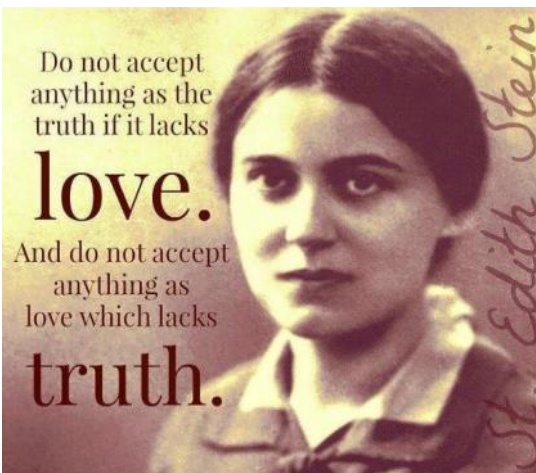

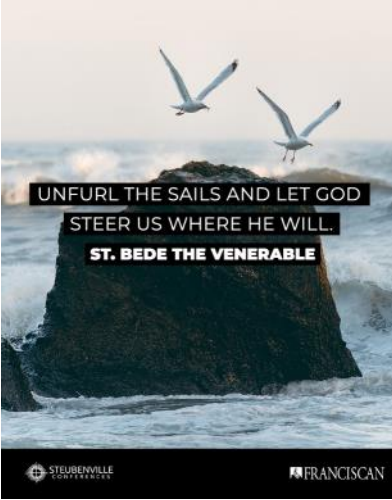

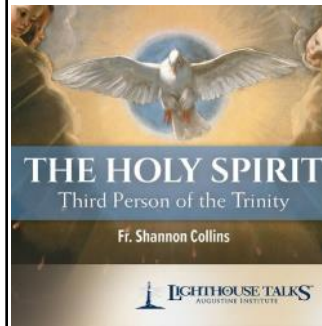

If you haven't been back yet... come and join us now! Don't stay away from the Eucharist unnecessarily! We are able to be bold in scheduling in this way because of the gift of having an associate pastor here with us! We will very likely make further modifications to the weekend Mass schedule for the August 22/23 weekend.

This week I'll be hosting our Seminarians' Retreat here at St. Al's! Our ten seminarians will gather with men who are open to priesthood (it looks like about 8 will join us this year), as well as with Bishop John. It's the one time each year that we are all together in one place. Please pray for our seminarians, and for the discerners. God-willing, Dcn. Ben Rivard is preparing to be ordained a priest next spring, and Christian Flagstadt and Brandon Yanni are preparing to be ordained transitional deacons. There's plenty of work in the vineyard!!!

We continue to work on plans for the upcoming school year! A lot has been accomplished this week. I had a great Zoom meeting with our St. Anne's catechists. However, much remains to be finalized at both parishes. Please pray for our staff and parish leaders as they work hard to get ready. Whatever comes, we'll keep working together, praying together, and cooperating with God's grace!
