Maybe you've noticed it before... we have a magnificent mosaic of the scene from this Sunday's Gospel in our cathedral in Marquette, under the patronage of St. Peter. It shows the moment when Peter received the Keys of the Kingdom. The Latin text is this line: "...you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven."

Jesus made provision for the faithful handing down of His teaching, His authority, His gifts... the Church! Over the Church, Jesus placed Peter and the other Apostles and their successors. We don't have to create a structure for the Church... Jesus gave us that!

In our own time many people are drawn to the idea of approaching Jesus without the Church or apart from the Church... or even seeking to approach God without Jesus. "I'm spiritual but not religious." There are lots of reasons for this... but as Catholic we approach Jesus and God in just the way that the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit communicated to us... we encounter Jesus in His Living Body, the Church! May God keep us faithful in His Church, and may we cooperate with His grace to foster new life and fervor in the life of the Church.

We're moving back into our school year schedule this weekend, and our separate St. Al's & St. Anne's bulletins. Please note the changed Mass times this weekend. Let's all pray for all our school administrators, teacher, professors, students and parents as this school year begins. **God guide us in every complexity and struggle!**

We've got a different schedule to kick off the Faith Formation year... some outdoor events in September and classes starting on Sunday, Oct. 4th, God-willing. We're also going to try some Saturday morning Masses JUST for families with little kids: 9 am on Aug. 29 and Sept. 5, 12, & 19.

We haven't been taking up a collection at Masses during the Offertory, but we have been putting out the basket. **Please keep St. Anne's on your radar screen for tithing... we need your support now more than ever!** I am full of gratitude for all your support and encouragement thus far!

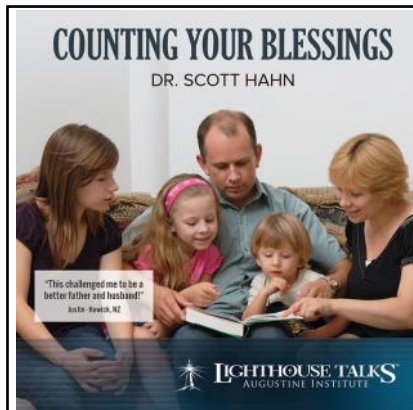
