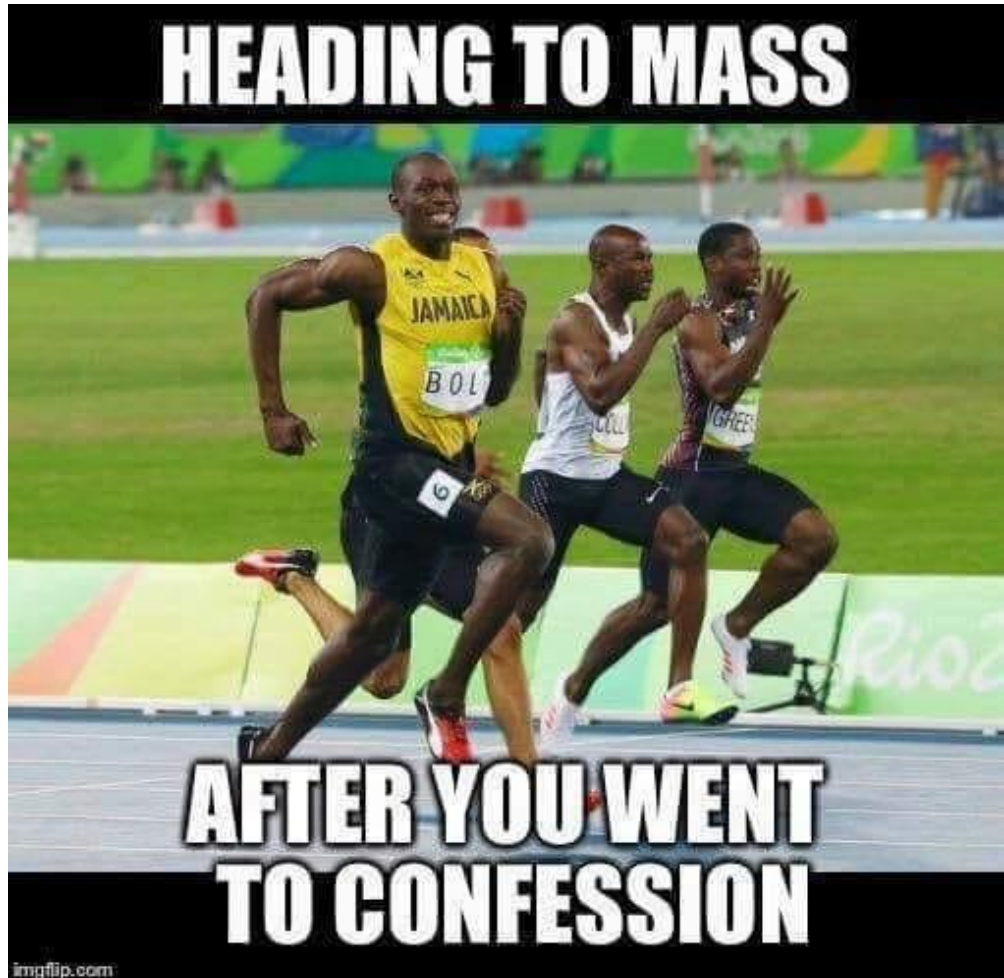

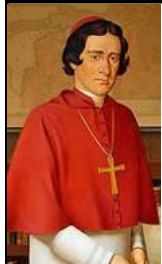

Our St. Anne’s St. Vincent de Paul Conference has a program through which we give away **\$50.00 coupons** redeemable at **WALMART** for any child aged toddler thru seniors (18) enrolled in the “free/reduced lunch program” at the Chassell Township School (even if not a Chassell resident).
