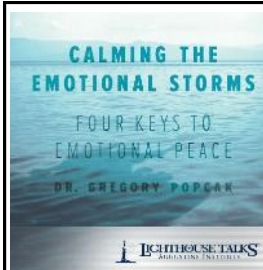

Today we celebrate the great **Solemnity of All Saints!** This day is set aside by the Church to remind of us joyfully of all the saints (both canonized and not) in heaven! We are surrounded by “so great a cloud of witnesses,” people of every walk of life who have gone before us, and who pray for us! At every Mass we are particularly reminded that we pray with the Saints, and they intercede for us before the Father’s Throne!

On Monday we celebrate the **Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, commonly known as All Souls’ Day.** We are reminded of the three “parts” of the Church: the church militant (in the battle of this earthly life), the church triumphant (glorious and victorious in Heaven), and the church suffering (in the purification of Purgatory). All those in the Church are connected by prayer: in the midst of the battle, we ask for the Church Triumphant (in heaven) to pray for us, and we pray for the Church Suffering (in Purgatory).

Please note **the four Mass times for All Souls’ Day** listed to the right. It is not a Holy Day of Obligation... but it is a very beautiful and powerful day to go to Mass! Praying for the dead is a basic Spiritual Work of Mercy.

Prayer connects us here in this earthly life as well! **As Tuesday is Election Day, we will have a day of Eucharistic Adoration.** Many of us may be tempted to stay glued to the computer or TV all day... why not spend at least an hour “glued” to the Lord! **The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar at St. Al’s from 7 am until 9 pm. Call the parish office to sign up for a prayer time: 906-482-5530.**

**Boots/Jackets for Youth**

Our St. Anne’s St. Vincent de Paul Conference has a program through which we give away **\$50.00 coupons** redeemable at **WALMART** for any child aged toddler thru seniors (18) enrolled in the “free/reduced lunch program” at the Chassell Township School (even if not a Chassell resident). Also eligible are Chassell children who attend another school and are enrolled in the “free/reduced lunch program” and home-schooled children who are eligible for any other agency assistance.

The coupons are numbered and redeemable, one per child, up to 8 coupons per family. 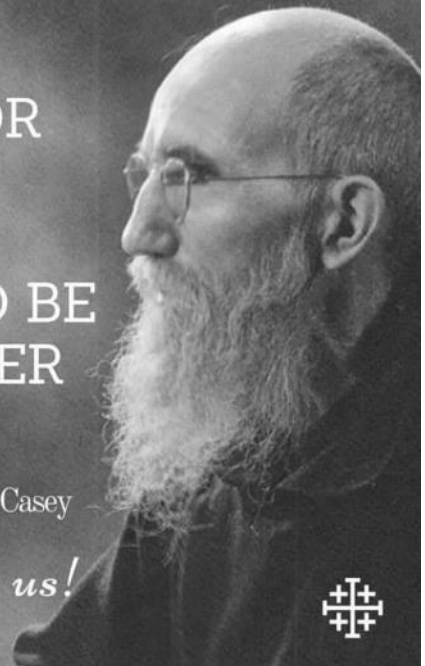

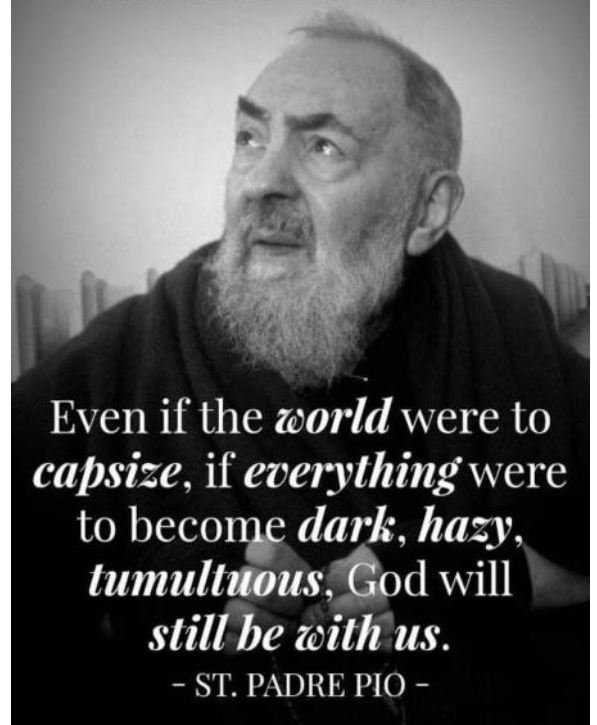
