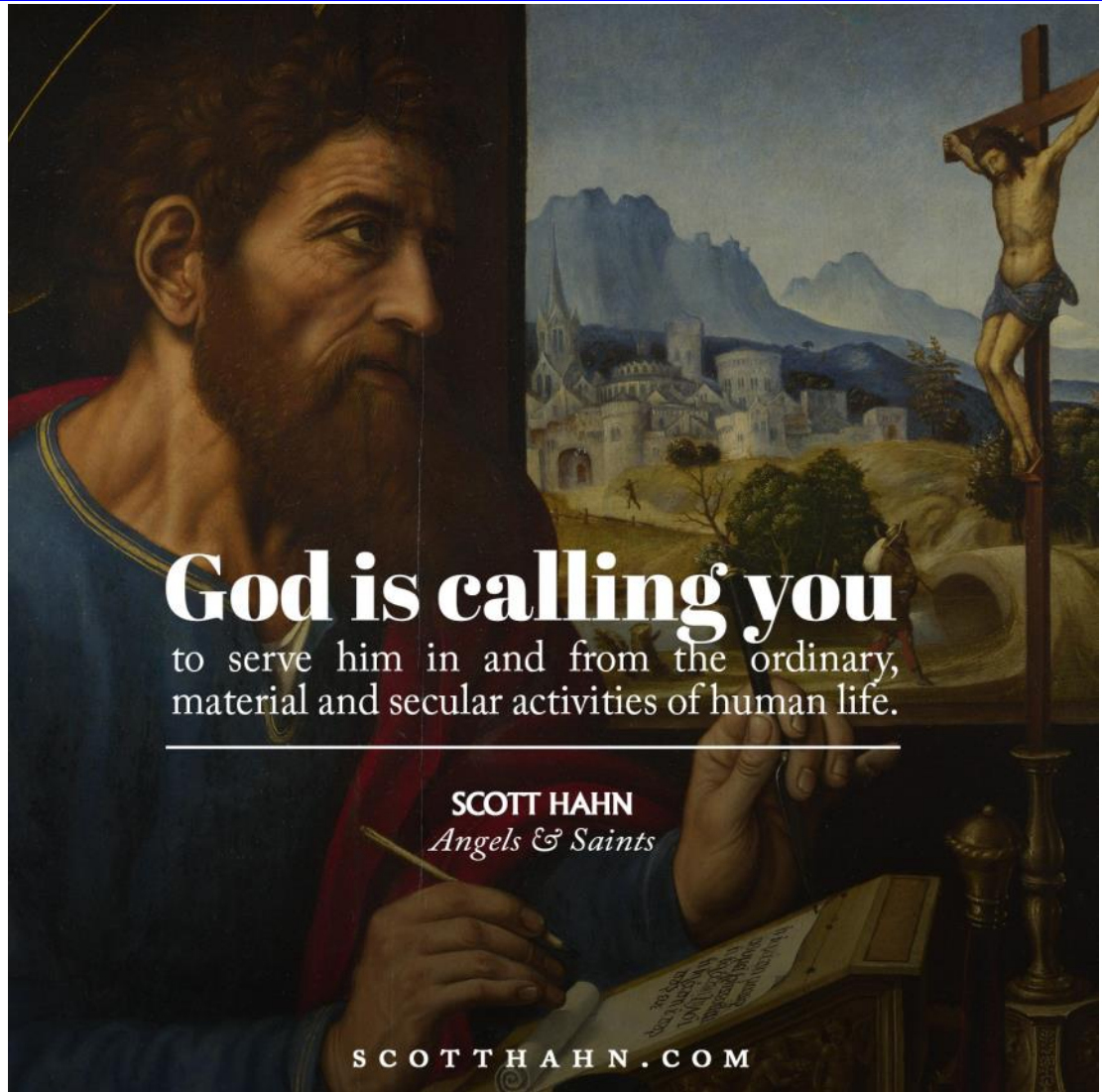

**The Body and Blood of Christ** In this informative presentation, Dr. Scott Hahn, a former Presbyterian minister, provides the biblical basis for the Church's teaching on the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and the significance of the Feast of Corpus Christi, and gives us a greater understanding of our vocation to be the living presence of Christ in the world.





“For all of you are children of the light and children of the day... Therefore, let us not sleep as the rest do, but **let us stay alert and sober.**” Thus our second reading from St. Paul’s First Letter to the Thessalonians.

I think St. Paul isn’t talking primarily about physical wakefulness, but rather about a **spiritual alertness**, whereby we are listening to God in our hearts and in His Word as we go through each day.

One of the best ways to maintain this wakefulness (necessary for our spiritual survival) is in the discipline of daily prayer. **A day when we have not prayed is a day when we are adrift, drowsy, unprepared.**

We’re doing our best to navigate this school year in the **area of faith formation.** A BIG thank you to Sr. Jacqueline and all of our catechists and parents as we all try to do our best! We’re continuing this week with some “hybrid” classrooms with some students online and others in person, we’ll see how it goes.

**THANK YOU to everyone who has already made their UPCSA pledge!!!** We’ve surpassed our goal by the biggest dollar amount ever (over \$6,900), and we also have our biggest percentage overrun ever! With that said... we’ve had 71% of our parish households contribute, but I would love to see more, whether those are pledges of prayer or financial gifts. Please send back your card!



It looks like we’re coming down the **homestretch on actually getting our refurbished stained glass windows installed!** We hope to see 5 of them installed this coming week! The one in the choir loft will wait until spring. It’s been a longer process than I anticipated... over two years since we acquired the windows from St. Sebastian’s in Bessemer. I think they will add considerable prayerful beauty to our already beautiful parish church!

**As we get closer to our civic feast of Thanksgiving, and during this difficult year, I think it becomes especially spiritually fruitful to attend to the reasons we have for gratitude!** I am particularly grateful to the faithful ministry of our staff: Fr. Tom, Sr. Jacqueline, Sr. Marcelyn, Sr. Carolee, Dcn. Tom, Sue, and Sara! These wonderful men and women serve our parishes with faithfulness and courage. Personally, I am keenly aware that they persistently put up with me!

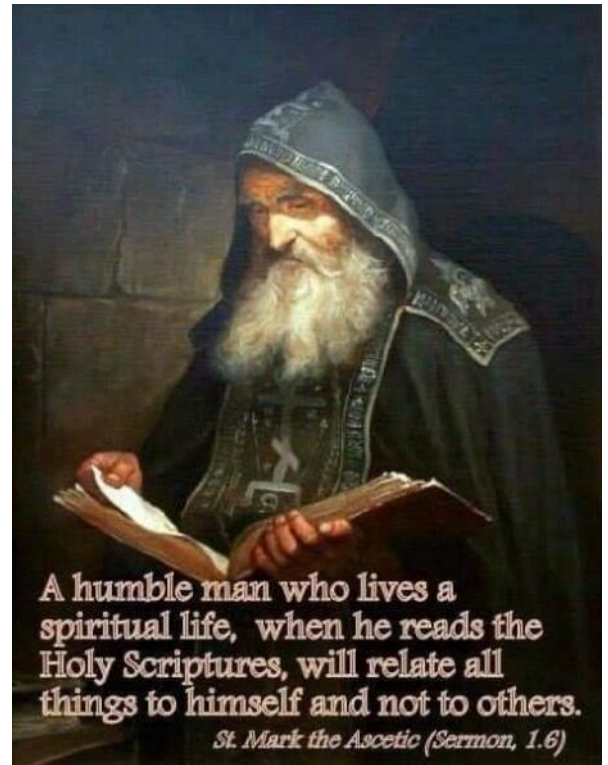

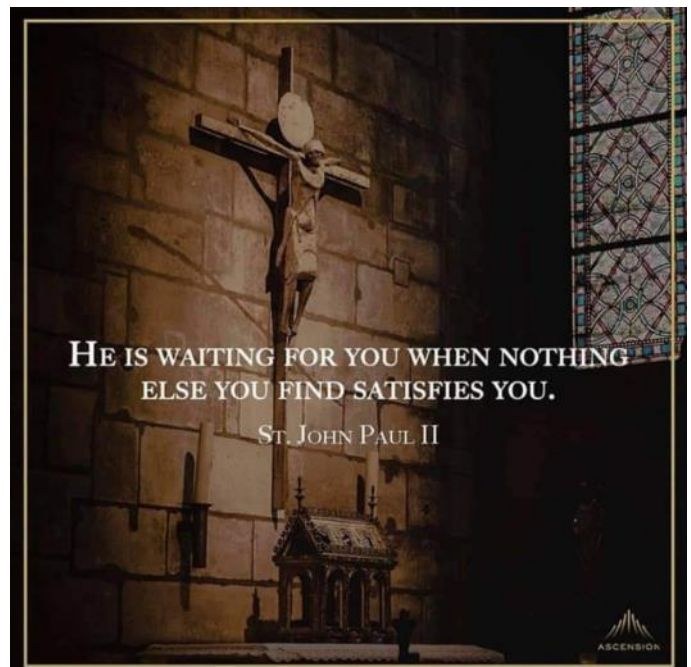
