
## Parking Lot Mass at St. Al's





“Thus says the Lord GOD: I myself will look after and tend my sheep. As a shepherd tends his flock when he finds himself among his scattered sheep, so will I tend my sheep. I will rescue them from every place where they were scattered when it was cloudy and dark.”

These words from the prophet Ezekiel, and they evoke the beloved words of our psalm, 23. In the most epic translation, “**Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil:** for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.”

Jesus Christ is King of Heaven and Earth, Lord and Ruler of all space and time. In His mighty power, in His tender mercy, **Jesus shepherds us through every dark valley...** even 2020! This has been a tough year, to put it mildly. However, Christ still reigns!

I think this is true EVERY year... but I can't think of anything more spiritually fruitful this week as we prepare for our civic feast of Thanksgiving than to be still and count the Lord's blessings. The struggles and limitations are real... but so are the Lord's graces. **May the Holy Spirit give us eyes to see God's blessings this year!**

**The process of installing 5 of our 6 refurbished stained glass windows has begun!** One or two of the existing windows should be out by the time you read this and the holes are getting re-sized. The custom frames are in the side entrance. The actual stained glass will nest into those frames. Pretty soon we'll be able to see those beautiful windows shining with God's light! I'll have more details about the saints depicted in the windows in the weeks ahead.

Stained glass occupies a role in Western church art somewhat akin to the profound and beautiful icons of the East. As the light changes, the windows take on different nuances and tones. The good things of creation are drawn into depicting the beauty of God's grace at work in the lives of the saints. It is my devout hope that these windows won't just be pretty! **May they enliven our hearts with the call to holiness!**

These windows are brought to us by the generosity of several families in our parish... and they were originally dedicated to St. Sebastian's in Bessemer by families there about 110 years ago! **I'll be saying more about this in the weeks ahead, but for now... you know who you are, thank you!**
