## **Basic Pandemic Safety Reminders**

- If you have a positive COVID test or COVID symptoms, please do not come to Mass.
- Please wear a **mask** in church.
- Please **sanitize** your hands when you arrive, and before communion in the pew, if you can.
- Please observe **social distance spacing**: every other pew is blocked, a spot for one or two people at each end. If you're a family of three or more, please take a whole pew.
- Bishop John encourages everyone to receive **communion** in the hand, and please **stay spaced** out in the line.
- No collection: but please put something in the basket up front if you can! We are grateful for your support!

#### **Increasing Church Seating Capacity**

Bishop John recently issued a letter regarding church capacity. "[E]ffective on Easter, pastors are given the discretion to increase the capacity of their churches, while maintaining all of the rest of the COVID-19 safety protocol." As per my recent letter to parishioners, at St. Al's and St. Anne's, we seem to be doing fairly well with having adequate seating, so we will be leaving the blocked off pews in place for now.





"Jesus said to his disciples: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower.... Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing."

Friends, our Gospel passage today is deeply true, deeply necessary, and deeply challenging! I think it is SO easy to be vaguely connected to Jesus, to be exteriorly connected to Him, to be His acquaintance... but it is very countercultural to really be rooted and grounded in Him, and to cooperate with the Father who prunes us! I think we often believe that we can bear much fruit on our own, but that's not true!

This Saturday (May 1<sup>st</sup>) is our last Saturday for our current schedule (4 pm St. Anne's, 5:30 & 7 pm St. Al's). Next <u>Saturday, May 8<sup>th</sup></u>, we will shift back to the summer schedule, so St. Anne's Saturday Mass will move to 5:30 pm, with Parking Lot Confessions starting at 4:30 pm.

I emailed you Bishop John's most recent letter regarding our practices for navigating the pandemic, and it is also in this bulletin as an insert. At St. Anne's we will keep our current practices largely in place for the time being. Bishop John describes this update as being in force through June 15th. God-willing, we may be able to make further modifications in the weeks ahead. We will be adding back some singing, incrementally, and making other small adaptations as we go.



This Sunday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, we'll be celebrating Jane Filpus' First Communion at the 9 am Mass! Please pray for Jane and her family, and for all the children who will be making their First Communion this spring around the world!

In the coming weeks, we hope to have **the stucco repaired** around the windows of the side entrance, and **the final stained glass window installed** up in the choir loft!

We're also looking at the possibility of installing some solar panels on our detached pole barn. Initial calculations and design suggest this could save us 20 to 50% of our electrical bill...stay tuned!
