From the desk of Fr. Ben... 30 May 2021



“Then Jesus approached and said to them, ‘All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit,** teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.’”

These are Jesus’ final words in the Gospel of Matthew, and right here we hear the basic formula of the Trinity, spoken by the Lord Himself! Each year on the Sunday following Pentecost, the Church invites us to meditate upon **this deepest mystery of the Faith, a glimpse into the mystery of God: three Persons, one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.**

Please keep praying for newly-ordained Dcn. Christian and Dcn. Brandon, for Dcn. Ben Rivard who will be ordained to the priesthood on June 4th, and for all our seminarians, and for an outpouring of vocations in our diocese! **It is a great joy to announce that just this past week, Bishop John accepted Charlie Tackman as the newest seminarian for our diocese.** Charlie is from Escanaba, and spent this past year as an active student at St. Al’s!

Last weekend I had **Mat and Kiaya’s wedding** near Detroit, this weekend I have former-chapel-rat **Daniel Killick and Amelia Scott’s wedding** near Appleton! Please keep praying for all our newly married and engaged couples.

On Monday we install an 8.5 kW array of solar panels on St. Anne’s pole barn! We’re also continuing to upgrade more of our lighting to LEDs in hopes of reducing our power bills even more!

I’ve been putting a lot of energy this week into getting ready for another summer of Totus Tuus! This year will be a little smaller: we’ll have just two teams of missionaries, and they’ll be serving at 10 or 12 sites across the U.P. Please pray for these fine young men and women who are devoting their summer to helping us hand on the faith to our youth K-12.

One of our Totus Tuus teams will be serving here at St. Al’s on June 13-18... talk to Sr. Jacqueline to get all your kids signed up!
