St. Anne's Solar Installation is nearly complete!

21 - 405W panels yield an array of 8.5 kW. The wiring is nearly done, and we hope to see the system producing electricity shortly! Our estimates suggest that the system will produce about 10,000 kWh of electricity per year, which is about 40% of our current parish usage. In the coming month we hope to install a similar system at St. Al's!

Updated Pandemic Practices

Please receive communion reverently, either in the hand or on the tongue. In either case, the act of reverence encouraged by the US Bishops is a bow of the head as you step forward to receive.
- We will be returning to our normal collection process as soon as we have the ushers ready to go.

From the desk of Fr. Ben...

This past week, Sr. Jacqueline and Rhen and I had our first round of St. Al's gatherings with an event Monday evening in Milwaukee and Tuesday evening in Appleton. In between we had the chance to make a visit to the beautiful Marian shrine, Holy Hill, in Hubertus, WI.

These events are really important opportunities to engage St. Al's alumni, friends, parents, current students, and prospective students. While we tried to replace them last summer with Zoom gatherings, it just wasn't the same! We've got three more trips ahead, one this week (in Minnesota), and then two more in the second half of July in lower Michigan.

This past week, Sarah Williams and Renata Sommerville were able to begin their training in **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd**. This catechetical method has roots in the Montessori movement and came to the U.S. in the 1980s. It has proven to particularly powerful and effective for small children, helping them grow in knowledge and understanding of God and of the Sacraments. This fall, with the assistance of Julie Catherino (who is already trained), we look forward to **introducing this method in our St. Anne's Faith Formation, as well as in the St. Augustine Homeschool Co-op.**


This training was supported by a generous grant from our diocesan **Legacy of Faith Endowment!** We also benefit from a substantial grant to the Totus Tuus program that cuts the program fees paid by parishes in half. LOF has also supported the NFP instructor training for Kylie Hoehn who helps us prepare engaged couples and anyone else who wants to learn the method. It makes a BIG impact in our community!

At the end of July we're going to be part of a local **Steubenville Conference for 7th-12th graders hosted at St. Ignatius.** We'll have more details in the weeks ahead, but please put it on your calendar, July 30 & 31!

As I type this, I'm about to head to Mackinac Island for wedding 6 out of 6! Come Holy Spirit! *God Bless, Fr. Ben*


