Updated Pandemic Practices

Please receive communion reverently, either in the hand or on the tongue. In either case, the act of reverence encouraged by the US Bishops is a bow of the head as you step forward to receive.
- We will be returning to our normal collection process as soon as we have the ushers ready to go.

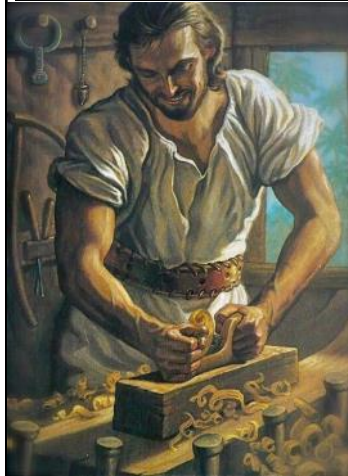

From the desk of Fr. Ben...

4 July 2021



"They said, "Where did this man get all this? What kind of wisdom has been given him? **What mighty deeds are wrought by his hands! Is he not the carpenter, the son of Mary, and the brother of James and Joseph and Judas and Simon? And are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him.**

This strikes a chord with me as we celebrate the 4th of July. These folks thought they knew Jesus, and so they were pretty resistant to what He was actually

doing and preaching. Here in the U.S., so much has been shaped by the Christian faith of most people in our country's history. **However, in our own time, most people don't actually know Jesus Christ... they just think they do. If that's going to change, it should start with us examining our own hearts: Lord, do I know You, and do I actually serve You and follow You?** Where are you calling me to know and love and follow You more faithfully?

I had a great meeting with the team that is going to implement the **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd** for our 3 to 6 year-olds this coming school year. This catechetical method has roots in the Montessori movement and came to the U.S. in the 1980s. It has proven to be particularly effective for small children, helping them grow in knowledge and understanding of God and of the Sacraments. This fall, we look forward to **introducing this method in our St. Anne's Faith Formation, as well as in the St. Augustine Homeschool Co-op.**

This training was supported by a **generous grant from our diocesan Legacy of Faith Endowment!** We also benefit from a substantial grant to the Totus Tuus program that cuts the program fees paid by parishes in half. LOF has also supported the NFP instructor training for Kylie Hoehn who helps us prepare engaged couples and anyone else who wants to learn the method. It makes a **BIG** impact in our community!



At the end of July there will be a local Steubenville Conference for 7th-12th graders hosted at St. Ignatius. We'll have more details in the weeks ahead, but please put it on your calendar, July 30 & 31!
