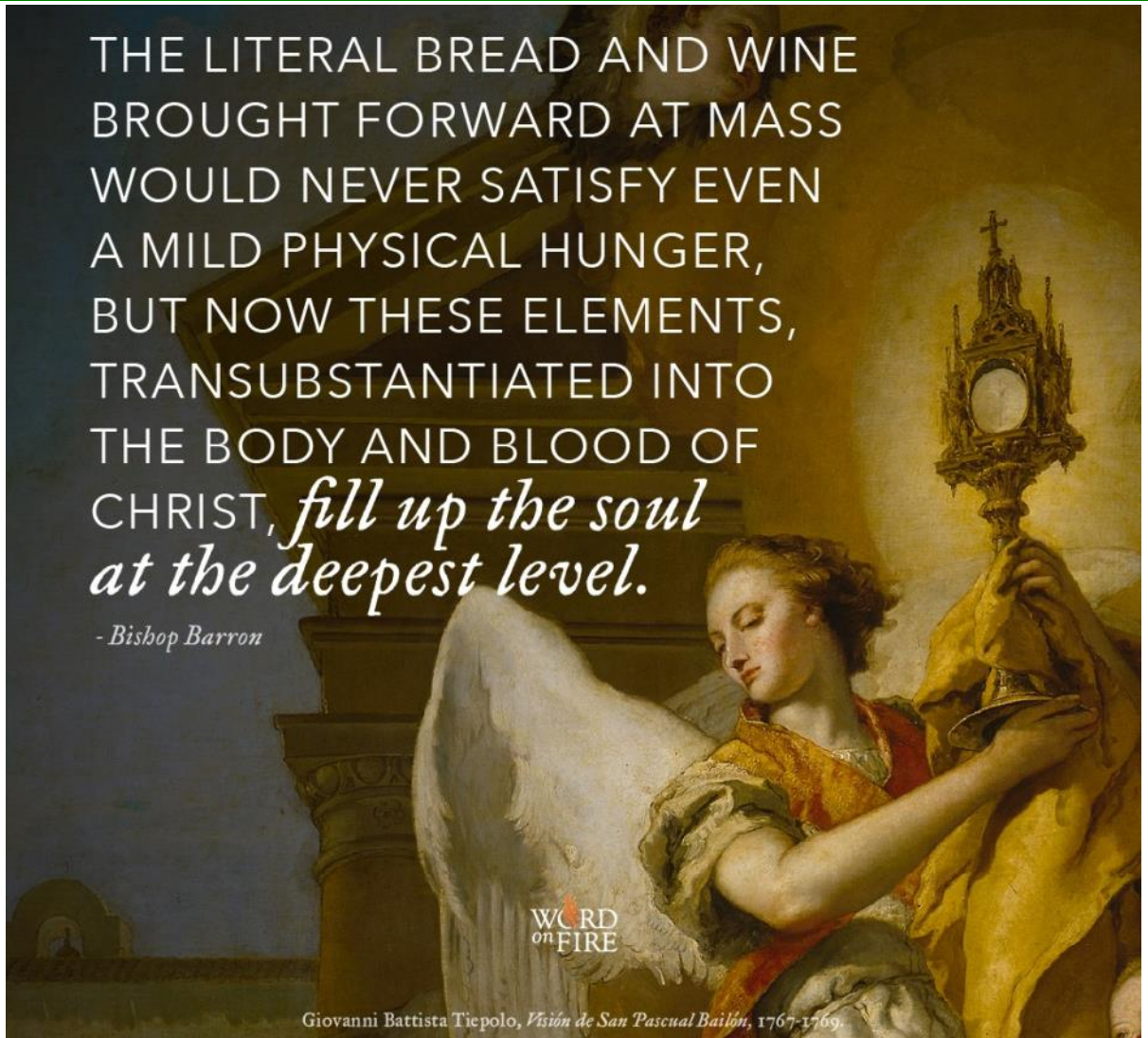

From the desk of Fr. Ben...

25 July 2021



St. Anne's is celebrating her patronal feast this weekend! The proper day is July 26, but we move it to a weekend every year so we can celebrate more fully! Good St. Anne, pray for us!

Every parish is entrusted to a saint (or title of the Lord or the Blessed Mother, or to a mystery of the Faith). We are not to live the faith alone, as isolated individuals, but as members of a family, the Church. Our patron saints are one beautiful reminder of this!

Starting this Sunday, we will hear from the 6th Chapter of the Gospel of John for 5 weeks. This is an intense passage where Jesus unpacks the reality of the Eucharist which is His Body and Blood, and without which we perish.

Bishop John, and now the US Bishops, are calling us to Eucharistic Revival. This involves our own deeper conversion and preparation to receive the Eucharist... and it involves **prayerfully and boldly inviting the hundreds and thousands of local Catholics who do not practice back to the Eucharistic celebration, the Mass.**

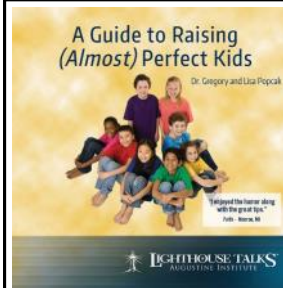
Please make use of the bulletin insert! I attempted to lay out the whole Gospel of John, with the 5 passages that are read in the lectionary marked out, and to line them up with the First Readings we will hear from the Old Testament along with them. This is how the Lectionary is built, and I think it can help us meditate deeply upon this important text!

As mentioned last week, I hereby commit myself and Fr. Tom to continuing the early Sunday Mass at St. Anne's (currently at 7:45 am), at least through the end of the year. It will likely move a little earlier in late August due to the return of our fuller (and slightly longer) celebration of the Mass. (There will also be Mass schedule updates at St. Al's as the school year begins.)

NEXT FRIDAY & SATURDAY, there will be a local Steubenville Conference for 7th-12th graders hosted at St. Ignatius, July 30 & 31!
