

So Jesus said to them,
"Amen, amen, I say to you, it
was not Moses who gave the
bread from heaven; my Father

heaven. For the bread of God

world." So they said to him,
"Sir, give us this bread always." Jesus said to them, "I
am the bread of life; whoever
comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in
me will never thirst."

Having manifested His power to multiply the loaves and the fishes, now this Sunday we hear Jesus provide His authoritative commentary on what He has done and what it means. He fulfills the gift of manna in the desert, He is Himself the Bread of Life.

Please continue to spend time with the 6th Chapter of John this week. Read it slowly, spend time in silence allowing the Lord to speak to your heart!

Eucharistic Revival involves our own deeper conversion and preparation to receive the Eucharist... and it involves prayerfully and boldly inviting the hundreds and thousands of local Catholics who do not practice back to the Eucharistic celebration, the Mass.
