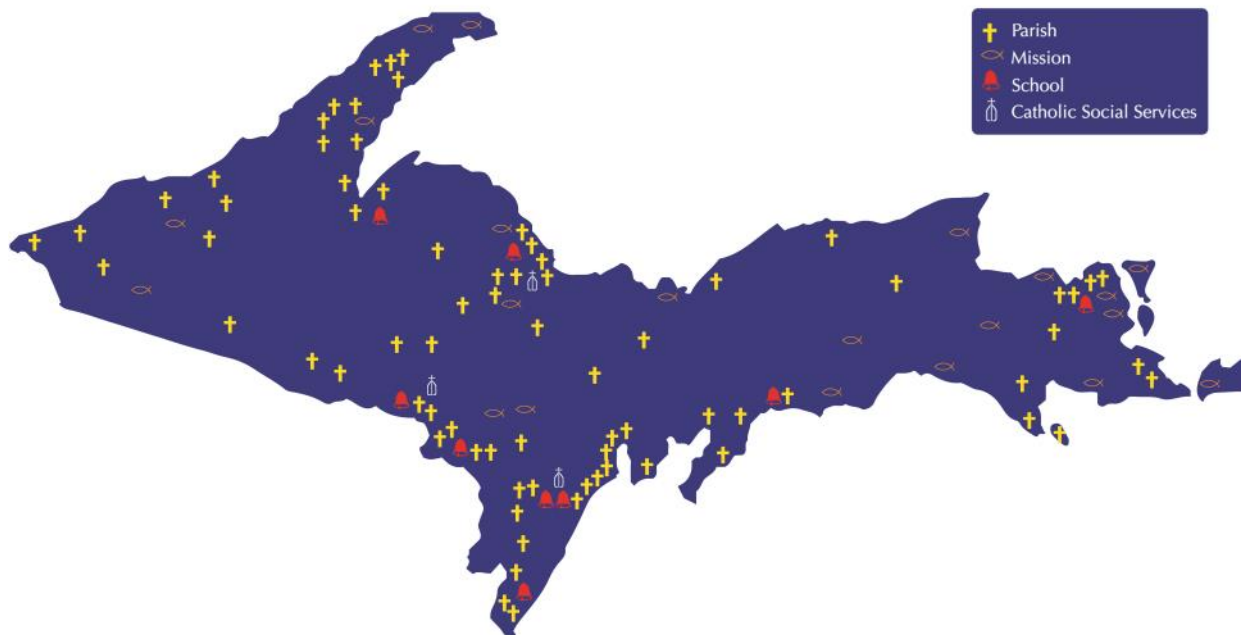
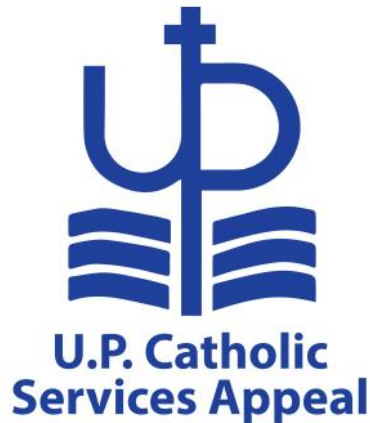

Updated Pandemic Practices

- If you have a **positive COVID test** or **COVID symptoms**, please do not come to Mass.
- You may consider wearing a **mask** in church if not fully vaccinated for your own safety and for others.
- Consider sanitizing your hands when you arrive.
- **For communion**, we will continue to have people come up single-file. Priests will sanitize their hands before beginning to give communion. Please receive communion reverently, either in the hand or on the tongue. In either case, the act of reverence encouraged by the US Bishops is a bow of the head as you step forward to receive.
- We will be returning to our normal collection process as soon as we have the ushers ready to go.

“He was teaching his disciples and telling them, ‘The Son of Man is to be handed over to men and they will kill him, and three days after his death the Son of Man will rise.’ But they did not understand the saying, and they were afraid to question him.”

Maybe they were afraid to ask... and maybe they were afraid He would say it again. Maybe they were afraid to let go of their own definition of victory!

In our first reading from Wisdom 2, we discover that **Jesus in fact fulfilled no**

small number of prophecies precisely in His suffering and death. Nonetheless, that’s not what people wanted to hear.

In fact, as Jesus is talking of His suffering and defeat (in the eyes of the world), His Apostles were vying with one another for status in the Kingdom! Not only weren’t they listening to Jesus, **they were pointed in the exact opposite direction...** not towards self-emptying service, but to towards self-gratifying power. Yikes! Jesus is sledding uphill!

How about us!? How much to we listen to what Jesus is saying, especially when it’s hard or uncomfortable to listen? **May God open our hearts!**

We have shifted to our school-year schedule. If you are concerned about exposure to COVID, please consider wearing a mask. Alternately, remember that we have the 5 pm Parking Lot Mass at St. Al’s, and this is EXTREMELY low risk because you stay in your own vehicle.

As the new school year beings, we are suspending congregational singing again for a few weeks. I hope that will be temporary! Fr. Tom and I will start wearing masks while giving communion. During the Sign of Peace it is entirely acceptable to do something non-physical: a bow of the head, a smile, etc. I do not foresee us requiring masks at Mass, but anyone who wants to wear a mask is most welcome to do so.

We’re also going to delay the start of Faith Formation until early October. We hope this gives families extra space to navigate the beginning of the school year in local schools.

Sr. Jacqueline’s classes started this week, there’s still time to sign up and join in! There’s three of them, and they are all worth your time & study!

We just restocked our Catholic Answers “20 Answers” series, a great learning tool! We’ve had many of the titles... but there’s a good number of new ones, 47 in all! Please look them over and take some for yourself and for your family members and friends!
