Words of Wisdom from Bishop Frederic Baraga

"I exhort you to pray everyday – many times remember God; never neglect Him."

The LORD God said: "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a suitable partner for him.".... So the LORD God cast a deep sleep on the man, and while he was asleep, he took out one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh. The

LORD God then built up into a woman the rib that he had taken from the man. When he brought her to the man, the man said: "This one, at last, is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh..."

There are many voices telling us to doubt the Father's goodness and love in making us male and female and giving us our bodies. When challenged with divorce, in the Gospel Jesus points us back towards the Father's original plan and gift. "In the beginning..." We look to the Father's loving creative will to understand how to receive this gift!

It is certainly challenging to receive the gift of our bodies and sexuality well, certainly challenging to rise to becoming the men and women that God created us to be! One basic step is to **ask God for the grace and courage to trust that in the beginning He made us good**, and with His grace, we can be restored and healed and live rooted and grounded in that goodness. No woundedness or hurt is beyond God's mercy!

What an amazing response to UPCSAs! As I type this, we've already received 47 pledges totaling 96% of our goal! That's amazing, good work! Thank you to everyone who has already pledged, and to everyone who will pledge. Please respond quickly to the appeal, so we can surpass our goal and move forward.

COVID case counts have risen steadily in the UP in recent weeks. Fr. Tom and I will continue wearing masks while giving communion. During the Sign of Peace it is entirely acceptable to do something non-physical: a bow of the head, a smile, etc. I do not foresee us requiring masks at Mass, but anyone who wants to wear a mask is most welcome to do so. Alternately, remember that we have the 5 pm Parking Lot Mass at St. Al's, and this is EXTREMELY low risk because you stay in your own vehicle.

We are going to kick off Faith Formation this weekend, see the details in the left column. If you haven't already registered with Sr. Jacqueline, please contact her this week. Please pray for our faith formation children!

We just got news this week that longtime former parishioner John Knight died down in Texas. May he rest in peace. John was particularly generous and active in his service to our Knights of Columbus Council and to the KC Squires group that he led. Apparently he had been very sick with COVID in July and never really recovered.

This past Monday, we celebrated St. Vincent de Paul, and he has some good advice to the left!

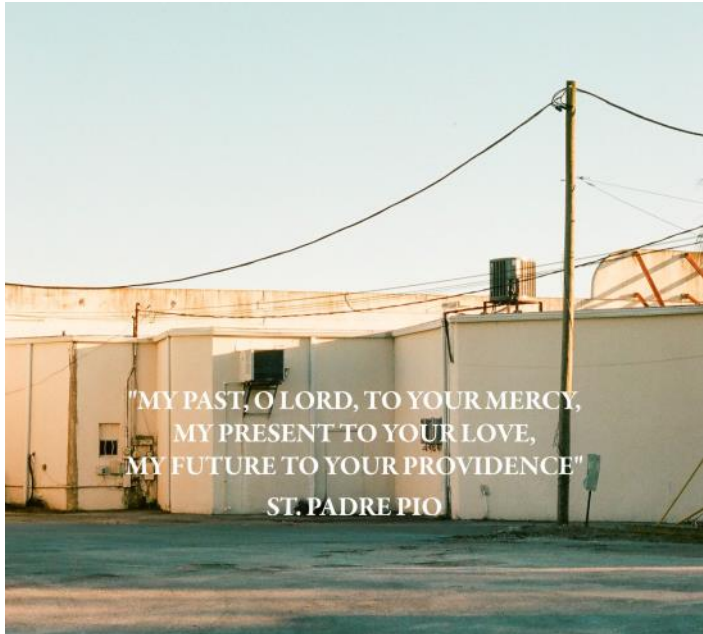
