**Catechesis of the Good Shepherd** is a Montessori-based approach to the religious formation of children, rooted in Sacred Scripture, Liturgy, and respect for the child's rich relationship with God. **Why is it called "Atrium?"** The word "atrium" means "portico, or porch entrance to a large house." The

Atrium was a term given to this space by Maria Montessori. It was chosen because in the ancient church, the atrium was a gathering space between the Church Proper and the street. It was the place where the catechumens, those preparing for initiation to the Church, would receive instruction. The Atrium has a similar purpose for our children, as it is a place to help them enter into full, conscious and active participation in the liturgical and communal life of the Church.

**Updated Pandemic Practices**

- If you have a **positive COVID test or COVID symptoms**, please do not come to Mass.

I am very grateful to Sr. Jacqueline and our catechists, and to Sarah Williams and everyone involved in the co-op. **May we all pray for our families and students as God works in them and through them.** We're all part of the process of handing on the Faith to the next generation!

For both Faith Formation and for Co-Op, we have a new dynamic this year, **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd**. Sarah is leading this with the help of Julie Catherino (for Faith Formation) and Renata Sommerville (for Co-Op). To the bottom left you'll see the first of a series of short articles about CGS, the first one is about the space or classroom they use, called the "Atrium."

**What an amazing response to UPCSAs! As I type this, we've already received 64 pledges totaling almost 120% of our goal!** That's amazing, good work! Thank you to everyone who has already pledged, and to everyone who will pledge. Please respond quickly to the appeal, we hope every parish household will participate!

Alternately, remember that we have the 5 pm Parking Lot Mass at St. Al's, and this is EXTREMELY low risk because you stay in your own vehicle.

Fr. Tom is covering in Iron Mountain this weekend at Immaculate Conception Parish. The pastor, Msgr. Kaczmarek, has just had double knee replacement, please keep him in your prayers for healing and recovery. I'm grateful for Fr. Corbin being available to help out on Sunday morning at St. Anne's. He'll be helping out next weekend as well, because Fr. Tom and I will both be at the Fall Campus Ministry Retreat. There's a lot of work in the vineyard!
