#### VOLLEYBALL GAMES

- **WIAA guidelines will be followed (Page 39-41 of the attached document)**
- 'Each SACRED HEART player will be allotted two ADULT tickets per HOME game night. This means two fans per child.
  - **All spectators will be required to wear masks. Masks can only be pulled down when drinking or eating concession items in the bleachers.**
  - All spectator children MUST REMAIN SEATED WITH PARENTS.
  - Roaming the halls during games will not be allowed.
  - Playground will remain closed during game events.
- For Away events, parents will sign in at the main door of the visiting school. Only TWO SPECTATORS PER ATHLETE WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER
- Fans can only stay for their specific child's game. If they have a child on C team and A team, they must leave after the C Game and come back for the A game. If a family has athletes on multiple teams, they will then be allowed to stay.
  - At the conclusion of the match, ALL fans will exit out Door 3/Emergency Door.
  - Fans will be asked to wait in their vehicle until it is time for their athletes' game to begin. Because of limited space, we cannot have fans stand in the hallways until immediately before a game begins.
  - A red and green light will be placed outside Door 2 to signal that the gym is open for the next game
  - An assigned Sacred Heart volunteer will be on Door Duty to help keep track of fans and tickets. Sacred Heart Volunteers will also assist in moving fans in and out of matches faster.

- Additional time will be provided to allow for the gym to be emptied appropriately
  - Tentative Match start times are as follows
    - C Team 4:00
    - B Team 5:15
    - A Team 6:30
- Social Distancing will be enforced, with bleachers moved, and limited capacity.
  - Home fans will sit on South wall bleachers.
  - Visiting fans will sit on North wall bleachers
  - Mask will be required for all Spectators
- Fans with any symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to attend volleyball events.
  - Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, along with any other illness remain home. Do not come to events if you are sick.
- Only athletes of the current match will be allowed on the gym floor. All others must stay seated.
- Modified concessions will be provided. Everything will be pre-packaged to limit the contact of food items. No shareable condiments will be provided.
  - Plexi glass will be installed on the Concession stand to provide workers and fans
  - All Concession stand workers will wear gloves and masks during shifts.
  - No table will be available in the hallway. Fans and players must sit in the gym and dispose of all garbage items to help avoid surface contact.
- Athletes must come dressed to play. Locker rooms will not be available, except for changing if needed. Only two athletes will be allowed at a time.
- Athletes will sit with their team until their match begins and must remain with their team until the match concludes.
  - In order to maintain social distancing and minimize contact, athletes must stay with their team. Athletes have been at school all day. Minimizing contact with others will help stop spread of any illness someone may have.
  - Visiting team athletes will sit on the far northeast corner of bleachers.
  - Sacred Heart athletes will sit on the stage.
- Hand Sanitizer will be made available in the gym and in high contact areas.
- All balls will be sanitized between matches.
