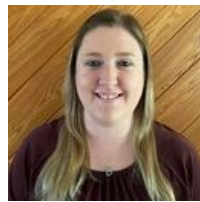
A Minute of Mass

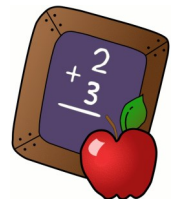
Nicole Seefeldt
