In case you did not get a chance to see the insert, here is a brief recap of it: *“All the ends of the earth have seen the saving power of God.” –Psalm 98* With so many evils present and hearing about them so much from the news, we can often wonder, “Where is God?” The Nativity and Incarnation of The Word mean “God-with-us,” and God always trying to do more with us. Incarnation literally means to make physically present.
