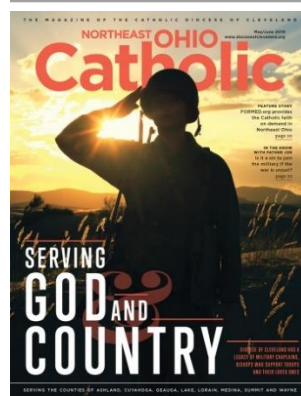

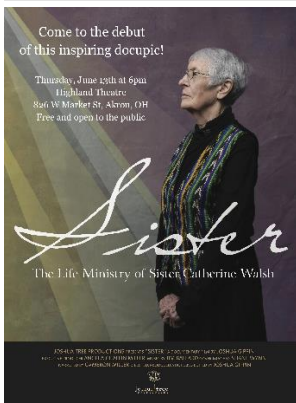

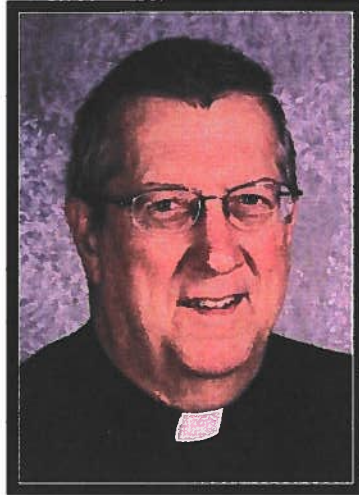

Rev. Francis J. Basa

Father Frank Basa, born in Bedford, Ohio, May 28, 1944. His mother, Helen Panovich and father, Frank Basa brought him up in the practice of Faith. Father has three younger sisters: Chris (Hal) Kiggins of Burton, Ohio. Kathy Sejba of Brecksville, Ohio and Nancy (Frank) Spencer of Ocala, Florida. A nephew, Fr. Tony Sejba, is Pastor of St. Francis Xavier Church in Medina, Ohio.

After attending St. Mary Elementary School in Bedford, he graduated in 1962 from Chanel High School and was enrolled in Hall of Honor. After spending five years at Borromeo College Seminary in Wickliffe, Ohio, he was granted a BA in History in 1967. He enrolled in St. Mary Seminary in Cleveland and after four years was granted a Master of Divinity Degree. Bishop Clarence Isenmann ordained Father Basa to the priesthood on May 29, 1971 for the Diocese of Cleveland.

Fr. Basa has served at St. James in Lakewood, St. Augustine in Barberton, St. Bernard in Akron, St. Martha in Akron, Christ the King in Akron and St. Hilary in Fairlawn. His present assignment in Senior Parochial Vicar at St. Bernard and being a mentor to its young Pastor, Fr. Chris Zerucha.

During the summer college days, Fr. Frank was on staff at Camp Christopher in Bath, Ohio. He continues to enjoy yearly camping with the senior. He has served many years on the Summit County CYO Board representing the camping section and has received its Hall of Honor Award.

Because of his Slovak background, he became a local branch officer in the First Catholic Slovak Ladies Association and has attended their national convention as a delegate. As State Chaplain to the Catholic Daughters of the Americas, he has participated in numerous National Conventions.

While at St. Martha Church, Fr. Basa accepted the invitation to become Chaplain to Northeast Akron Council 3529 and was elected Grand Knight for two years. He continues to attend functions at St. Hilary Council 14551 and St. Bernard Council 457. He is Faithful Friar of Msgr. Joseph O'Keefer Assembly 818 and has served as Cleveland Diocesan Friar for the last six years.

Fr. Basa's main outside activity began as a Cub Scout and then a Boy Scout at the age of eleven. Since then, he is an Eagle Scout and Wood Badge trained. He received the Add, St. George and Silver St. George Emblems, OA Vigil Member and attended NOACC ten times. He has served over 40 years on the Executive Board of the Great Trail Council in Akron. He has been honored with the Silver Beaver and Silver Antelope Awards. He served nine times on the Staff of the National Camping School and is a veteran Jamboree Staffer as well as an International Dalajamb (Europe- 79', Australia - '82 & '85). He has attended the BSA National Jamboree 3 times between 1973 and 2017. He has accepted a Staff position as Chaplain to the 24th World Scout Jamboree in July 2019, at the Summit in West Virginia.
