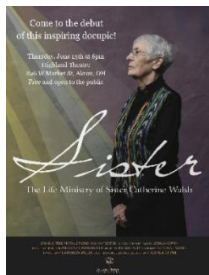
MONTHLY GRIEF SUPPORT
