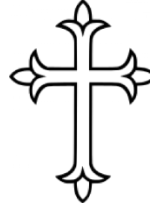

The Women's Board of Catholic Charities Corporation of Summit County

The Women's Board of CCC/SC promotes the programs of Catholic Charities Corporation of Summit County through volunteer service and fundraising events. There are currently 51 members. The members are from many different parishes throughout Summit County. Meetings are held once a month from September through May. Each year the Board has two major events. The first is the Christmas "bags of love" program in which members adopt families selected by Catholic Charities. Last year 30 families received "bags of love" filled with personal gifts, cleaning products and toiletries. And second, a fundraising luncheon/auction is held every March. With the proceeds from the 2019 fundraiser, the Women's Board gave \$16,500 to Catholic Charities of Summit County; \$11,000 for counseling, \$4,500 for Camp Christopher Camperships, and \$1,000 for the Hot Meals program. The next meeting of the Women's Board will be at Blessed Trinity Church, 300 E Tallmadge Ave in Akron on Friday September 13 at 9:30. We welcome guests and new members! PASTOR'S NOTE

#SolutionsToViolence, Part 2 www.RAND.org reported in 2018 that the term "Mass Shootings" is difficult to define and is not standard in its use. Looking at victims that died by gun violence in the United States in 2015, they list two conclusions: 1. Depending on the definition used, between 7 and 371 mass shootings occurred in the United States in 2015; 2. No matter what definition is used, the frequency of the use of the term "mass shooting" by the media has increased significantly in recent decades. One murder is one too many. We must work as hard if not harder to resolve violence as we do talk about it, lamenting it and condemning it. Remember this from

chemistry class? Something soluble it will dissolve in liquid and that that liquid is the solvent. The thing being dissolved is the solute and the combination of the two is where the word solution comes from. So, what is the solvent in which we will dissolve the solute of violence? Two more ideas this week: Luke 23:34: "Forgive them, Father; they know not what they do." Violence is not an appeal to the justice of God but takes justice into one's own hands. Justice belongs to God (Dt 32:35). Our command from Jesus is to forgive those who do us wrong and is the response of Jesus on the Cross right in front of the very ones who put Him there. Why? BECAUSE they did NOT know their own fault. Forgiveness always dissolves the urge to be violent. Lastly, we can find many possible solvents in this prayer that disarms our pride and self-worship, written by St. Francis: Lord make me an instrument of your peace. Where there is hatred let me sow love. Where there is injury, pardon. Where there is doubt, faith. Where there is despair, hope. Where there is darkness, light. And where there is sadness, joy. O divine master grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it's in dying that we are born to eternal life. Amen. The world is full of the solute that is violence. Let us provide the solvent. Father Chris
