The Catholic Commission of Summit County Advisory Committee has passed a resolution in support of Summit County Issue 14, the 2.95 Mill Renewal Levy for the Summit Co. Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADM) Board, on the November 5, 2019 ballot.
