PASTOR'S NOTE

General Update:

St. Bernard's: The building restoration is coming along nicely with already six weekly progress reports having been issued by HMH Construction, the contractor for this major phase of the building restoration. A few more totally loose large stones have been located in the ridges of the belltowers, aka, the watertables, and they have been removed and will be replaced with new, comparable stone. We are keeping some of the removed stone and may find a way to turn it into commemorative items. The financial campaign has completed phase one and is moving into phase two this week by beginning major gifts recruitment. If you know of anyone who we should interview for this phase, please contact me directly! For example, I responded to a request from Cynthia Knight to call her, but now do not know where she is or if the number that I was given for her is the best one.

St. Mary's: Plans have been drawn up for a landscape renovation. A new sign on the corner has been designed and ordered. Downtown Akron Partnership reports that all Main Street construction will be completed by July 31st. The City or State owe us a fence along the Main Street side of the property at that time. A lift will be on-site again this Thursday to complete the envelope study of outside of both the school and church buildings. Covid-19 put a damper on our plans for an Alumni Association, but recently at Parish Council, we were in agreement to pursue this as soon as feasible. We also have to watch how we spend for these things. A comprehensive campaign will come in the Fall to renew our membership, awareness of our parish and perhaps raise funds for repairs indicated by the envelope study.
